Jack Park, MBA, CPA, CSP, is a highly rated national presenter who is scheduled to speak in 31 different states across the nation in 2009. His clients include BMW, Microsoft, Home Depot, Merrill Lynch, Edward Jones, Nationwide Insurance, Ashland Chemical, and 46 different State CPA Societies.

In 1989, Jack founded Financial Insights, a consulting and educational development firm, after serving twenty-two years with four major corporations.
